Rhynocoris rubrogularis (Horváth 1880) (Heteroptera: Reduviidae): New Faunistic record for Turkey

ABSTRACT

Until now, there has been no record of *Rhynocoris rubrogularis* (Horváth, 1880) in Turkey. The specimen was collected from Ordu province.

INTRODUCTION

In 1997, one female has been collected from Ordu province, in the northwestern part of the Black Sea region of Turkey. This specimen is identified as *Rhynocoris rubrogularis* (Horváth, 1880) (Figs. 1, 2).

This specimen was collected in the southwest of Ordu Province, on a slope of the Canik Mountains range, close to the Blacksea coast.

Another species of this genus, *R. annulatus* (Linne, 1758) has been given previously as a new record in 1991 (Kiyak & Çaglar, 1991), from Rize province, in the Eastern Blacksea region of Turkey.
