New Records of Syrphinae (Diptera: Syrphidae) from Turkey

ABSTRACT

In 1995–1999, 4 species of the subfamily Syrphinae, *Platycheirus ambiguus* (Fallén, 1817), *P. angustatus* (Zetterstedt, 1843), *P. manicatus* (Meigen, 1822), and *Pyrophaena rosarum* (Fabricius, 1787) were recorded for the first time in fauna of Turkey, in the Ankara and Kastamonu provinces.

INTRODUCTION

Thus far, three species of the genus *Platycheirus* Le Peletier et Serville, 1828, have been recorded from Turkey: *Platycheirus albimanus* (Fallén, 1817), (Sarıbıyık & Aktaş, 1996, Sarıbıyık, 1999, 2000) *P. scutatus* (Meigen, 1822), (Sarıbıyık & Hasbenli, 1997, Sarıbıyık, 2000) and *P. peltatus* (Meigen, 1822), (Sarıbıyık, 2000) are recorded. Until now, no *Pyrophaena* species were recorded for the Turkish fauna.

During the years 1995 and 1999, 12 specimens of the subfamily Syrphinae were collected during fieldwork in the provinces of Ankara and Kastamonu.
